Please find below to a brief description of the expenditures that were paid from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.

Healing Transitions in Wake County: \$5850.00 was paid for 130 days to the Healing Transitions in Wake County for substance abuse treatment and specifically for detoxification services and recovery treatment.

Oxford Houses- These are a clean and sober living housing options for individuals in recovery and/or treatment from Substance Abuse, which Trillium assists in the start-up costs at \$6,000.00 a home. Brunswick County added 1 Oxford House.

Purchase of Naloxone Kits: Trillium purchased and distributed in Brunswick County 113 Naloxone kits at \$8,475 to the Brunswick County EMS.

Access Point Kiosk – The Kiosk provides anonymous evidence-based self-conducted screenings for mental health and substance use to potentially link individuals to appropriate services. The annual cost is \$1,181.00 for these kiosk per year.

*Substance Abuse Treatment Services: \$2,299,364 was paid for 692 individuals from Brunswick County to providers for substance abuse treatment.

These Substance abuse treatment expenditures were spent for the treatment of alcohol or substance abuse. These funds were paid to providers who contracted with Trillium to provide substance abuse treatment to consumers with an address in your county. Services provided include but are not limited to the below:

Assessment/evaluation

- Outpatient treatment and counseling, including face to face and telepsychiatry and both individual and group
- Mobile Crisis
- Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient Therapy
- Facility Based Crisis
- Opioid Treatment
