EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO GOODS AND SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Eighth Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Eighth Amendment") is made and entered into the 3rd day of October, 2022, by and between Brunswick County (hereinafter referred to as "County") and North Carolina Sound of Goldsboro, LLC (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

WITNESSETH:

- WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into a Goods and Services Agreement (the "Agreement") effective August 18, 2020, for the Project, as defined in the Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into an Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "First Amendment") effective March 4, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Second Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Second Amendment") effective March 15, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Third Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Third Amendment") effective June 7, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Fourth Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Fourth Amendment") effective August 15, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Fifth Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Fifth Amendment") effective October 25, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Sixth Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Sixth Amendment") effective December 15, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, County and Contractor subsequently entered into a Seventh Amendment to Goods and Services Agreement (the "Seventh Amendment") effective May 20, 2022; and
- WHEREAS, the need for additional video conferencing has been identified to include WebEx integration into the existing audio-visual systems in Courtroom 6; and
- WHEREAS, the need for additional security features for certain points of entry and exit have been identified to include access controls, card readers, and exit sensors; and
- WHEREAS, the additional video conferencing and security features resulted in additional costs and fees other than those set forth in the Agreement and all prior amendments.
- NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements as set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:
- 1. The Proposal for the addition of WebEx integration into the existing audio-visual systems in Courtroom 6 as well as the aforementioned additional security features is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

- 2. Except as otherwise amended herein, all other terms of the Agreement and all prior amendments shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This Eighth Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall be considered one and the same. This Eighth Amendment may also be executed electronically. By signing electronically, the parties indicate their intent to comply with the Electronic Commerce in Government Act (N.C.G.S § 66-58.1 et seq.) and the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (N.C.G.S § 66-311 et seq.). Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Eighth Amendment by either electronic means or by facsimile shall be as effective as a manually executed counterpart.

NCS will relocate access control from 1092a to door 1117a, this will include new cabling pulled back to panel P100a and terminated on existing MR52 board where 1092a was terminated. We will relocate existing card reader, then provide new door position switch, cable, and request to exit sensor. Locks and hinges to be relocated and installed by others.

NCS will relocate access control from 1093a to door 1064a, this will include new cabling pulled back to panel P100a and terminated on existing MR52 board where 1093a was terminated. We will relocate existing card reader, then provide new door position switch, cable, and request to exit sensor. Locks and hinges to be relocated and installed by others.

We will provide new card reader, door position switch, cable, and request to exit sensor. Locks and hinges to be provided and installed by others.

RFP-57 Rev1

NCS will provide Card access override on Door 2200B, this will include new cabling for Door 2200B to be pulled back to Panel P200B and terminated on spare MR52 board. Card reader will be provided on the hurry assembly side of the door and will only operate the shunt feature of the alarm to allow exit without setting off the alarm. Door hardware conversion of existing egress device, alarm kit, mortise cylinder, power supply and power transfer will be provided and installed by others.
